

The [Calgary Catholic Immigration Society](#) (CCIS) will deliver ECO Canada's [Environmental Immigrant Bridging](#) (EIB) Program from Tuesday February 21, 2012 – Thursday April 5, 2012 (8:30am-4:30pm).

This is not a technical training program.

PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The program consists of classroom training and work experience.

A 180-hour classroom curriculum covers:

- resume writing
- interview skills
- project management
- Canadian workplace culture
- environmental issues
- technical writing for the environment sector



Depending on your area, this may be complemented by work experience opportunities such as:

- networking events
- informational interviews
- job shadowing
- mentoring
- volunteer opportunities
- work placements

The work experience component is approximately **8 weeks in length starting on Monday April 9, 2012.**

N.B. ECO Canada and CCIS are NOT placement agencies. There is no guarantee that program participants will obtain a work placement. The purpose of the program is to gain the skills and knowledge required for participants to seek employment-related opportunities in a supported and guided environment.

APPLICATION PROCESS

Please ensure you meet the following eligibility requirements for the program:

- Minimum of five years of experience working in an environmentally related field
- Degree or a diploma in an environmentally related area ([Foreign Credential Evaluation required](#))
- Minimum Canadian Language Benchmark (CLB) of 7 in all four areas: reading, writing, speaking, and listening ([proof of proficiency required](#))
- Underemployed or unemployed
- Eligible to work in Canada
- Commitment to attend classes and complete course activities
- Self-motivation and strong dedication to independent employment search
