About the EYC Internship Program

The Environmental Youth Corps (EYC) Internship Program gives eligible employers up to \$15,000 to hire interns for full-time, meaningful environmental jobs related to science, technology, engineering, or mathematics.

Funded through Environment Canada's Science Horizons Internship Program, EYC Internships typically last between 8–12 months and are intended to lead to permanent employment.

Who's eligible?

Hosts

- Canadian owned or a Canadian subsidiary
- Offering a full-time, permanent position
- Providing an environmental position in science, technology, engineering, or mathematics
- Planning to hire a new employee (the intern cannot be an existing employee)

Interns

- Intend to lead an environmental career related to science, technology, engineering, or mathematics
- 30 years of age or younger
- Eligible to work in Canada and a Canadian citizen, landed immigrant, or refugee status
- Graduated from a post-secondary institution
- Able to work in a full-time, permanent position
- Unemployed or under employed
- Have not participated previously in a federal youth employment or education program
- Not currently employed at the host organization
- Not a family member of the host organization's directors or senior officers
