EP(EMSLA) and EP(CEA) Approved Lead Auditor Training Courses

All EP(EMSLA) and EP(CEA) applicants are required to have completed a minimum 35-hour Lead Auditor training course that contributes to the development of knowledge and skills in:

- Environmental management systems and standards against which audits may be performed/ ISO 14001;
- Environmental science and technology;
- Technical and environmental aspects of various types of business activities and facility operations;
- Relevant requirements of environmental laws, regulations and related documents; and,
- Different types of environmental audits, audit procedures, processes, techniques, and guidelines for auditing, including ISO 19011.
